

Application for Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) for Sick and Homebound

To be eligible to be an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) a parishioner must:

- •Be a baptized and confirmed Catholic man or woman of at least 25 years of age. (A person under the age of 25 can be EMHC if he/she is recommended for delegation by his/her pastor.)
- •Be a registered parishioner in good standing at St. Edward the Confessor Parish, which means you are a person who sincerely tries to live the Gospel message in your communal and individual life. If you are married, you should be married in the Church (divorce does not make one ineligible to serve as an EMHC.) You should faithfully participate in the Sunday Eucharist and, with God's grace, strive to live your faith in every aspect of your life
